

FPC sees the role of associated co-workers in the same way that Paul saw the role of Aquila and Priscilla, who are mentioned in his epistles.

He showed obvious confidence in them, stayed in their home, and when he left Corinth for Ephesus¹, he took them with him. He left them in that city to

work towards planting a church, while he returned to Jerusalem. Priscilla and Aquila persevered in Ephesus, where the church met in their home².

Paul refers to them as “fellow-workers in the service of Christ Jesus³”, which shows the respect he had for them!
